

CONTRACT AGREEMENT**

THIS AGREEMENT, made this day 9 of January , 2018,

by and between the City of Port Arthur, a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of Texas, hereinafter called "OWNER" or "CITY" and Inland Environment ^{SA} ~~S~~ Ltd. a (n) individual, firm, partnership or corporation herein acting by and through Kingwood, Texas hereinafter called "CONTRACTOR"

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the payment terms, conditions and agreements set forth herein, OWNER and CONTRACTOR agree as follows:



3. During the term of this Contract, the Contractor will furnish at his own expense all of the materials, supplies, tools, equipment, labor and other services necessary to connection therewith, excepting those supplies specifically not required of Contractor in the Specifications.
4. The CONTRACTOR agrees to perform all the work described in the specifications and contract documents and to comply with the terms therein for the sum of \$ 23,760.00 .
